Tips and Reminders

- Prior to match week programs must elect whether to participate or not.
- No programs that participated in the match are allowed to sign applicants during soap week unless participating in SOAP.
- Applications are by ERAS only.
- Reviewed status of applicants from the interviewing season are available in ERAS during the SOAP.
- Have a well-defined applicant criteria and utilize ERAS filters to sort through applicant pool.
- ERAS filters can be set up prior to SOAP.
- Once applicant contact is initiated by program, further contact is allowable anytime, even during SOAP rounds.
- Applicants can submit up to 30 programs prior to round one.
- Students do not make a rank list. They can receive multiple offers during a round and then decide.
- In each round, a program can only offer the number of positions they have available to that many applicants.
- During SOAP rounds, when applicants are unavailable they drop down a program's list. Lists can be adjusted between rounds.
- If an applicant allows an offer to expire in any round they reject that program and cannot be offered again by that same program in another round.
